BUS SERVICE NOTE

Regular one-way, round-trip and 10-trip or 20-trip railroad tickets issued by Reading Railway and reading between points between bus service is operated, will be good on buses.
 Where buses do not directly serve railroad stations at places shown they stop at nearby points on the highway. See separate folder for specific stops and intermediate service.
 Note—Under local restrictions passengers will not be carried whose journey is entirely within the following zones:
 Stowe—Sanatoga Wissahickon—Philadelphia
 Through passengers will be carried from point in one zone to points in another.
 Combination of railroad tickets will not be honored on buses when point of combination is not served by bus, or when one of the tickets reads between two points between which buses are not permitted to carry passengers due to local restrictions.
 Bus tickets reading via Reading Transportation Co. between Philadelphia and destinations west of Norristown or vice versa will be honored between Philadelphia and Norristown (DeKalb Street) on Reading Company trains shown in this time table as direct connections for buses.
 Baggage service is rendered for the convenience of bus patrons but the company does not assume responsibility for loss of or damage to baggage due to any cause.
 Hand baggage limited to 60 pounds per passenger will be carried free. Trunks will not be accepted.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This Time Table shows the times at which trains and buses are expected to arrive and depart from the several stations, but it is not guaranteed, and although every care is taken to keep the Time Table correct, this Company does not hold itself responsible for possible errors, or for delay or inconvenience resulting from failure to make connections advertised herein.
Adjustment of Fares. In the event of any disagreement with the Conductor or Bus operator relative to ticket conditions, privileges allowed, etc., passenger should pay Conductor or Bus operator, take his receipt and refer case for adjustment to the General Passenger Agent, who will promptly refund any overcharge. The Conductor or Bus operator has no discretionary power in such matters but is governed by rules which he is not authorized to change.
Redemption of Tickets. Tickets unused or partly used will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value.
 Ticket Offices at all important railroad stations are open before the departure of passenger trains and passengers are respectfully requested to purchase tickets before boarding trains and avoid payment of extra charge.
