- INTRODUCTION -

This code book is for use of Conductors, Agents, Yardmasters and any one reporting movement of cars. Under no circumstances should any other code be used.

Conductors of both Freight and Passenger trains, as well as Agents and Yardmasters, will find detailed instructions for preparation of wheel and interchange reports.

Attention is directed to the importance of accuracy, legibility and promptness in the preparation and forwarding of reports. All subsequent car records and car accounting is dependent on information contained in these reports.

If any instructions are not clearly understood, take up with immediate superior, who will furnish the desired information promptly, or, consult with Office of Superintendent Transportation if necessary.

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Instructions to all Conductors concerning the proper preparation of Wheel Reports.

GENERAL

1. The **SYMBOL NUMBERS** of the **STATION CODE MUST BE USED** by all conductors to report the movement of cars on their wheel reports, and under no circumstances should telegraph code or symbols issued by other departments be used for this purpose.

2. It is most important that all information both in the heading and body of your report be accurate, complete and legible. It is particularly important that car initials be properly shown in accordance with official markings. Initials of cars of private ownership are suffixed with an (X). In reporting such cars it is necessary in all cases to show the full markings such as GRCX-GATX, etc.

3. Conductors will make a carbon copy of the reports on plain paper for their record. The carbon paper must be changed frequently to insure clear copies. You must also make sure the carbon is properly inserted so that original and copies are complete. The carbon copies are to be kept together and filed in the office of the trainmaster (to whom each conductor reports) at the end of the month, where they will be available for future reference. There are, however, exceptions to this rule, and conductors having other instructions concerning the disposition of their copies will continue to dispose of them as heretofore.

4. All reports must reach this office promptly. Conductors of thru trains must have them completed at the end of each run (not round trip). All other conductors (freight and passenger) must have them finished at the end of a day's work. They must then be mailed to the Superintendent Transportation, Philadelphia, Pa., on the first available train.

Instructions to Conductors of Freight and Coal Trains

Rule 1. (a) Every train must be reported on the

proper form as designated below:—

- Rdg.—Local trains operating on Rdg.
Co. only Form 4095 No. 6
- Both—Thru trains operating on Rdg. & CNJ Form 4095 No. 3
- Both—Thru trains operating on Rdg., CNJ & B & O Form 4095 No. 3
- Rdg.—Thru trains operating on Rdg. & W. M. Form 4095 No. 5
- Rdg.—Thru trains operating on Rdg. & PRR Form 4095 No. 4

(b) If trains consist of light engine or engine and caboose only, write across the face of the report "No Cars Moved."

(c) The caboose must be shown under the proper caption in the heading of report, then in body of report commence at engine and list cars as they stand in train.

Rule 2. (a) Weight for both car and contents must be shown separately in tons of 2000 lbs. in columns provided for this purpose. In computing weight of contents, 1000 lbs. or more shall be considered as one ton. For example:—Stenciled weight of car is 39,300 lbs., weight of contents 20,700 lbs., insert in column 5 the figure 20, and in column 6 the figure 10. When the actual weight cannot be obtained the following estimated weights of contents shall be used:—

Less carload shipments, including distributing locals 5 Tons

Carload shipments of steel rails, iron ore, coal, grain, sand, brick, oil, ties, pig iron, lumber, and other bulky material, the marked capacity of the car shall be used.

(b) When the light weight cannot be ascertained from the stenciling on the car or from the car ticket, the following table must be used for this purpose:—

Dead engine	180 tons
Parlor and sleeper — steel	78 tons
Parlor and sleeper — steel underframe	74 tons
Vestibule coach — steel	57 tons
Vestibule coach — steel underframe	51 tons

Vestibule coach – wood	35 tons
Ordinary coach – steel underframe	49 tons

Box cars (34 feet long or less)	16 tons
Box cars (over 34 feet long)	25 tons
Refrigerators (36 feet long or less)	29 tons

Gondolas (low side)	22 tons
Gondolas (high side, 140,000 lb. cap.)	25 tons

Coal cars (100,000 lb. cap. and under 140,000 lb. cap.)	22 tons

(c) When weight of contents – carload lots – cannot be obtained or is not shown on car cards received from connections, conductors will report the facts to Supt. Transportation, Phila., Pa., giving initial and number of car, nature of lading and from what point shipped.

Rule 3. (a) When cars are drilled out short of destination, place a circle around the symbol representing the point at which the car is drilled out, and note on bottom or back of report full particulars, giving cause, nature of lading, destination, and extent of loss or damages to lading, if any.

(b) When passenger equipment is moved in train, in addition to initials and number, show kind of car in Column 4.

(c) Report each dead engine and each tender not in service as a loaded car, if on its own wheels, giving the initials and number, and report them in the order in which they stand in the train, marking them **ENGINE** or **TENDER**.

Rule 4. (a) Refuse to handle cars that are improperly or too heavily loaded, or that are not in safe condition to run, or having defects that endanger trainmen. When such cars are left at stations write with chalk

the words “Bad Order” conspicuously on each side of the car, and also mark with a cross any defective part, reporting such cases by telegraph to the Superintendent.

(b) See that each car ticket corresponds with initials and number of the car.

(c) Do not move a loaded car on a car ticket, or waybill that has been altered unless it shows by whom each alteration is made, or is properly endorsed and signed by the Yard Master or Agent; except when loaded with livestock or perishable freight. In such case report the error by telegraph to Superintendent.

(d) It is prohibited to move empty box cars over the road unless side doors are secured in closed position, conforming with Book of Rules instructions.

Rule 5. (a) Procure from the Yard Master or Agent a car ticket or billing for every car moved in your train (both loaded and empty) except empty system coal cars, which may be moved without tickets. NO car ticket or billing should be accepted without the car.

(b) Deliver to the receiving Station Agent or Yard Master the proper car ticket or waybill for each car. At a point where there is no Agent, deliver the car ticket to the Station Agent in charge, unless otherwise directed.

(c) Cars with carlot or less than carlot shipments moving on bills showing that they contain “Order – Notify” consignments MUST NOT be left at a non-agency station or placed on a private siding unless authorized by the Freight Agent in charge of such non-agency station or private siding.

Rule 6. Different kinds of cars must be designated as follows:–

A – Automobile	R – Refrigerators
B – Box	S – Stock
V – Box – Ventilated	T – Tank
G – Gondola	MW – Ballast
H – Open Top Hopper	DE – Dead Engine
LO – Hopper – Covered	ST – Scale Test

CK — Coke	CR — Crane Car
CN — Container	D — Dump
C — Coal	CT — Clearance Test
F — Flat	CAB — Caboose
LP — Live Poultry	W — Well

Rule 7. (a) Examine the seals on both sides and both ends (if the cars have end doors) of all box cars before you begin your run, or when taking them into your train. Also make a like examination of seals at point where cars are set out of train or at end of run.

(b) In case a seal is found to be broken or gives indication of having been tampered with, a report of the same must AT ONCE be made to the Agent or Yard Master at point of discovery, who will replace the defective seal with his own seal.

(c) Make a proper notation showing the character of the defect and at what point discovered, giving the name of the Agent or Yard Master to whom the defect was reported.

All broken parts removed from cars enroute, involved in train delays, particularly burst air hose must be turned over to the car foreman at terminal point.

When material of any kind is applied by train crews to foreign cars, prompt report shall be made on Form 573 by Reading Company crews, such reports to show car number and initials, whether new or second hand material was used and cause for application of material.

Rule 8. The Interstate Commerce Commission regulations require a special check and record of all placarded cars. Cars containing explosives require 4 placards and 2 car certificates. Cars containing other dangerous articles require 4 inflammable, 4 acid or 4 poison gas placards. Record of kind of placard must be made in Column 12 of Form 4095, using E for explosives, I for inflammable, A for acid and P for poison gas. Placard notation on car ticket must agree with placards on car, or be taken up for correction the same as if car numbers did not agree. Placards lost in transit must be replaced at first station stop, if local train, or at first yard terminal if through train.

Instructions to Conductors of Passenger Trains

1. A wheel report must be made for all passenger

trains on Form No. 442. Making separate reports for MU as against other trains.

2. When cars are drilled out of train short of destination, a note showing cause must be made at the bottom of report.

3. When trains are detoured account of wrecks, wash-outs, etc., a note showing how routed and all other information must be placed on report.

4. When train travels between points where an alternate route can be used the route taken must be designated alongside of the caption (routed via).

5. Cars which are locked and forwarded for use at other points, including private and pullman cars in charge of porters (and not used for passengers) should be considered as empty. Cars used at any portion of the trip should be reported as loaded.

6. Designate the kind of cars by letters as follows, except electric equipment which should be preceded by the letter E:—

C — Coach or Reclining	CL — Club, Lounge or Observation
CB — Combination, Carrying both passengers & baggage or mail, etc.	P — Parlor
DC — Dining Cafe—all cars serving food and drinks	S — Sleeper
Bag — Baggage	PR — Private or business
BM — Baggage & Mail (RPO)	MO — Motor
MS — Mail Storage	TR — Trailer
E — Express	BR — Refrigerator Express
	MK — Milk
	H — Horse

7. The weight of freight cars and contents must be shown by tons.

Instructions to Conductors of Work Trains, etc.

1. A wheel report for all work, wreck or non-revenue

trains, must be prepared on Form 4095—No. 6. Show extreme points between which each car is moved during the day and enter total mileage by each car in column number 13 headed "destination." If working back and forth in a stated yard limit, the mileage on each car shall be estimated and suitable notation made showing the territory or yard in which the service was performed. For example: "Yard Service—Allentown", etc.

2. Under the caption "Train" in the heading of report, be sure to identify your train as follows: Non-Revenue, Work, Wreck or Circus.

**Instructions to Agents, Yardmasters, Etc.,
concerning the proper preparation
of the Interchange Report**

1. The interchange report is the basis for our Per Diem settlement to foreign car owners. This is pointed out so you may readily realize the importance of same being accurate, complete and legible. It is particularly important that car initials be properly shown in accordance with official markings. Initials of cars of private ownership are suffixed with an (X). In reporting such cars it is necessary in all cases to show the full markings such as GRCX—GATX, etc. Special care must be exercised to insure carbon copies being as legible as the original. It is also suggested that where typewriters are available, report be compiled on them.

2. Every effort must be made to have reports reach this office the day after the interchange takes place. Mail reports to Supt. Transportation, Philadelphia, Pa., attention Car Record Department.

3. All ON HAND REPORTS, sent us by Agents, Yardmasters, Weighmasters, etc., must be made out to show the cars on hand in their territory as of the last day of the month. Reports must be mailed so they reach this office not later than the 5th of the month.
