

# THE WHEELING AND LAKE ERIE RAILWAY CO.

## INFORMATION

**Time Tables.** These time tables show the time at which trains may be expected to arrive at and depart from the several stations—every care is taken to keep them correct—but their arrival and departure at time stated, and the connections scheduled cannot be guaranteed. The times of trains shown herein are subject to change without notice.

**Buy Tickets** before boarding trains and avoid payment of extra charge. Children under five years of age free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; five years of age and under twelve, one-half fare, twelve years of age or over, full fare.

**Adjustment of Fares.** In cases of dispute with Conductors or Agents, pay the fare required, take receipt and communicate with General Passenger Agent, Cleveland.

**Redemption of Tickets.** Tickets unused, or partly used, will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value.

**Excess Collection on Trains.** This Company has its ticket offices open at least 30 minutes prior to departure of trains in order that passengers may purchase tickets. Passengers boarding trains without tickets at stations where tickets are sold will be charged ten (10) cents in addition to the regular ticket fare. This applies to children as well as to adults.

**Baggage.** One hundred and fifty (150) pounds of personal baggage will be carried free on each adult ticket and seventy-five (75) pounds on each half fare ticket. Passenger must present his ticket to the baggageman at time he asks to have baggage checked. If baggage is checked to a flag stop where there is no station, passenger must take his baggage from the baggage car door at once or else it will be carried to the first regular station stop beyond.

**Baggage Maximums.** No single piece of baggage exceeding 250 pounds in weight or 72 inches in greatest dimension, or exceeding \$2,500 in value, will be checked. Free allowances subject to tariff stipulations as to contents, weight, value and size.

**Liability Limited.** Excess value to be declared and paid for at time of checking.

**Bicycles (not motorcycles), Baby Carriages, Dogs and Guns** are transported in baggage cars subject to tariff regulations.

**Lost Articles** to be inquired for at General Passenger Department, Cleveland, O.

**The Railroad Company will not be responsible for unchecked articles left in station or cars.**

**Western Union Telegrams** accepted for transmission at all Agency Stations.

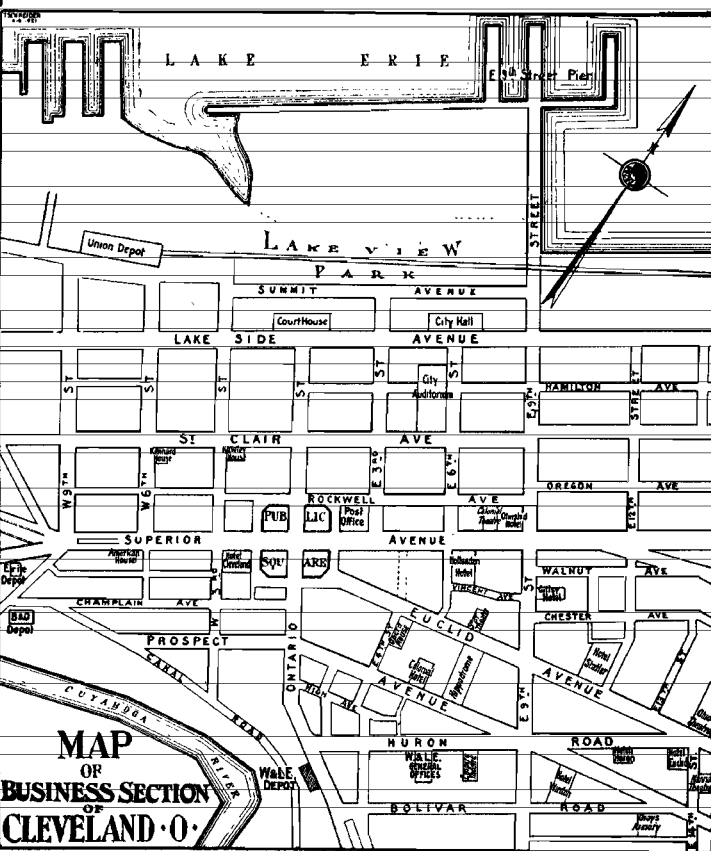

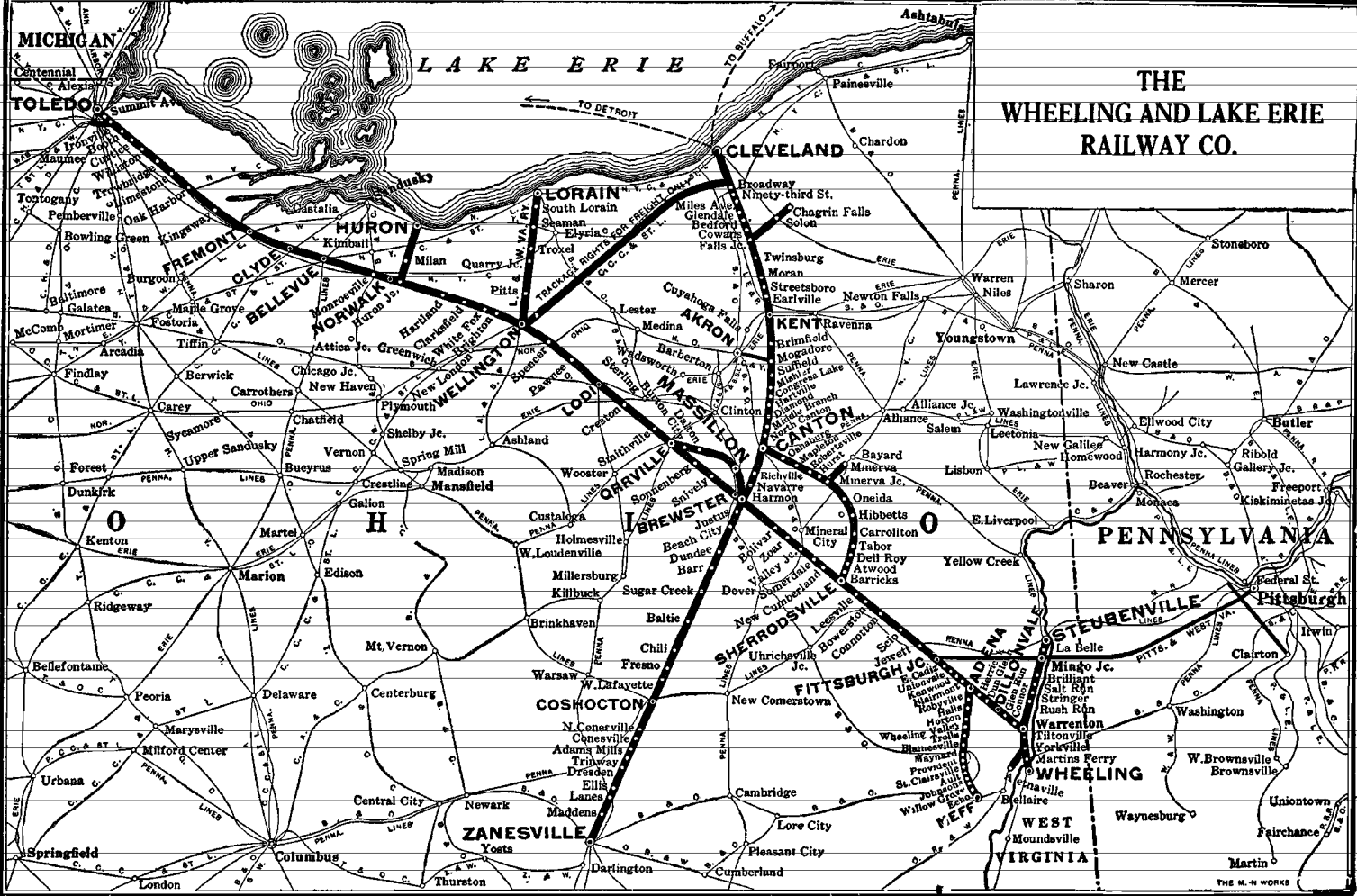
